Event Format

We are trying to generate an inviting space that allows all of us to think together by entering into a deep dialogue of mutual learning.

The setting for the multilogue session is the beautiful and quiet *Salle des boiseries* at UQAM.

We have organized the day into **four sessions**, making sure there is ample time for health breaks, breakfast and lunch.

For the first two sessions, the multilogue partners will be sitting in a circle, speaking with each other.

Outside of the dialogue circle, GRSP fellows and a select group of graduate students will be auditing the event.

The *first* session will be for the dialogue partners to get to know each other. Each of the speakers can make some opening statements, and invite others to reflect on specific issues throughout the day.

Following a health break, in the *second* session dialogue partners will continue the conversation.

After lunch, when we go back to the circle for the *third* session, the circle will have expanded in order to bring into the conversation the GRSP fellows and graduate students who were previously auditing sessions one and two. In this session, GRSP fellows and graduate students will initiate the multilogue by asking questions and presenting their points of view to the different speakers.

Following a health break, in the *fourth* session this larger circle of dialogue partners will continue the ongoing conversation. We can then bring the event to a close by discussing the publishing of an edited volume and the possibility of future collaborations.
